Project Number: RC07-000156 **Project Name:** Bridge Upgrade on Bethany Church Road over N Fork Ogeechee River

Project Description: Project CSBRG-0008-00(301) Taliaferro County proposes the replacement of the structurally deficient bridge on CR 82 over the North Fork Ogeechee River southwest of the City of Crawfordville. The project begins at MP 4.289 on CR 82/Bethany Church Road and ends at MP 4.590. This will be accomplished by closing CR 82/Bethany Church Road during construction, removing the existing 136ft x 24ft reinforced concrete bridge and replacing it with a new bridge in the same location. CR 82 will then be reopened to traffic. The roadway will consist of one, 11ft asphalt travel lane in each direction with 5ft grassed shoulders.
