Ensuring Safety and Security	This project would benefit the public by potentially reducing the incidence of crashes along this roadway segment, corridor, and/or intersection.

Example benefits could be: mitigating congestion (e.g. operational improvements) and optimizing capital asset management (e.g. resurfacing, rehabilitation). Additional Benefits	This project would benefit the public by potentially relieving congestion by adding a second left turn lane from eastbound Riverwatch to eastbound I-20 and widen the eastbound I-20 on ramp to accommodate dual turn lanes.
