Maximizing the value of Georgia's Assets

This project could potentially maximize the full utility of an existing transportation facility(s). In some cases, bypasses will be necessary. Additional Benefits

This project would benefit the public by constructing a westbound passing lane and an eastbound climbing lane on State Route 47. SR 47 between Clarks Hill Lake and Lincolnton has a moderately rolling terrain with inadequate sight distance caused by substandard vertical curvature and few opportunities to pass. The project could also improve safety by providing

safer opportunities to pass.
