The Georgia Department of Transportation presents an attached update on the TIA 2010 for the CSRA Special District. The total CSRA Special District's collections through October 31, 2013 for projects on the approved investment list is \$36,368,215.98.

There have been 25 agreements executed between the Department and Augusta/Richmond County for local delivery of band 1 projects totaling \$67,490,416.94. The Department has awarded 3 blended projects to construction from the Approved Investment List:
